This form must be completed if your child (children) is accompanied by someone other than the child's parents to an embassy to take a DNA test. We need this information about the person that accompanies the child as his or her guardian. The form only needs to be completed if the parent in Norway knows who is going to accompany the child to the embassy.

Guardian: in this context means the person who has daily care and control of the child/children and not necessarily the person who has parental responsibility.

Please note that inadequate information about the child/children's guardian can lead to longer case processing time.
